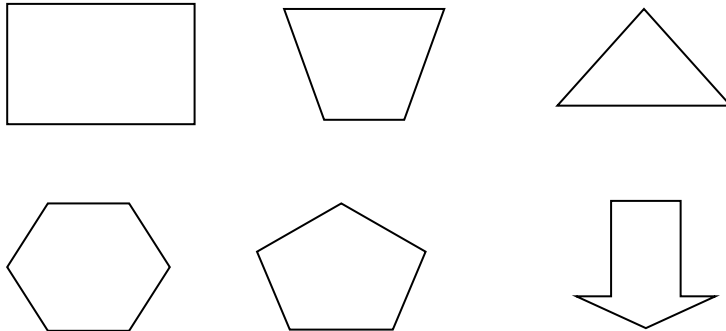
Question 1, 3 should be done in a scrapbook. Make a separate notebook for the rest of the questions.
